ATTENTION ALL 2010 CDC ALL STAR AUTOMATIC SPOT-ELIGIBLE DARTERS

This is a reminder that in order to be eligible for an Automatic Spot on the 2010 All Star Team, you must meet the following three qualifications:

- 1) Must achieve the minimum Phase I Score of 1,600 for Men or 1,100 for Women, on or before August 29, 2010.
- 2) Must have been a member of the CDC All Star Team in each of the previous two years (2008 and 2009).
- 3) Must have participated in a minimum of three (3) All Star Fundraisers prior to August 29, 2010.***

*** We would prefer that you meet qualification #3 by physically appearing and participating at the fundraisers. We feel it is important that you come out and meet some of the newer All Star candidates and help build team camaraderie as we prepare for this year's Quad City Challenge. However, we understand that individual circumstances may make it difficult to meet this qualification. Therefore, in lieu of your actual presence, you may receive credit for fundraiser participation by paying a \$10 fee per fundraiser. (e.g., if you attended zero fundraisers, you would be required to pay a \$30 fundraiser fee in order to retain your eligibility). This payment must be received along with your Phase I score by August 29, 2010. The fundraiser fee is not a substitution for a team fee (if any) that each team player may be required to pay. [Physical presence and participation at a minimum of 3 fundraisers is still required in order to retain eligibility for the Exemption Spot.]

Please note that we have only 3 remaining fundraisers scheduled between now and August 29th, so in order to avoid paying a fundraiser fee to retain your Automatic Spot eligibility; please make sure you attend a minimum of three fundraisers. Please contact Rose Scott (msrls@hotmail.com or 216/313-0556) or Jamie Clark (jclark822@hotmail.com or 440/390-9521) to determine the number of fundraisers attended, to make arrangements to pay the fundraiser fee or to arrange a date and time to throw your Phase I Qualifying score.

Our next fundraiser will be held on Saturday, July 17 at Highland Square Tavern. Phase I scores will be taken beginning at 6 pm, with a blind draw scheduled at 8 pm. We hope to see you there.

Sunday, August 29: Last Chance to post Phase I Score for eligibility for an Automatic Spot.

Saturday, September 18: Last Day for Phase I Qualifying & Automatic Spot Shoot-Off (if necessary)

Sunday, September 26: PHASE II QUALIFYING. Top 32 men and top 16 women will play off for the remaining spots on the team. (Automatic players are requested to attend and assist, if possible.)

NOTE: The Exemption Rule remains in effect. The Exemption is from Phase II for one man and one woman who recorded the highest Phase I score (after removing Automatic Spot qualifiers). To be eligible for this exemption, you must have attended at least 3 All Star fundraisers and have previously made the CDC All Star team at least once in the last six years.
